


## Strawberry Fields Festival Case Study



### Project Overview

Strawberry Fields Festival, celebrating its 15th anniversary in 2024, partnered with B-Alternative to enhance environmental sustainability through two core initiatives: the **Rewash Revolution** and **Camp Care Program**. These programs are designed to reduce landfill waste and foster conscious patron behaviour for over 18,000 patrons.

Within it's sixth year of integration, Strawberry Fields *Rewash Revolution* replaces single-use food and beverage containers with reusable alternatives for 28 food vendors. 2024 was B-Alternatives third year as the logistics manager.

Our Camp Care program, supports festival-goers to party with the planet by keeping campsites tidy and having meaningful conversations around sustainability and waste. Together, these initiatives not only minimise environmental impact but also strengthened Strawberry Fields community engagement around sustainability.



### Operational Model

B-Alternative delivered a full-service, end-to-end solution tailored to the festival's sustainability goals:



Reusable System Design

Supplied and managed the circulation of <u>52,559</u> reusable food and beverage items across <u>28</u> vendor outlets.



**RFID Deposit Systems** 

Collaboration with Festival Currency's
RFID wristbands to apply and
communicate crockery deposits/
returns.



High-Volume Wash Infrastructure

Strategic on-site commercial-grade wash stations capable of processing up to 10,000 dishes daily.



**Camp Care Program** 

Engaged directly with campers through peer-to-peer education on waste separation, responsible disposal, and Leave No Trace principles.



**Vendor & Patron Engagement** 

Delivered pre-event and live vendor briefings, instructional signage, and frontof-house staff to ensure simple adoption.



**Indigenous Education Partners** 

\$5209.6 donated to the Indigenous Education Foundation through volunteer donations and CDS collection.

### Environmental and Community Impact



#### **On-Site Cleanliness**

The shift to reusables contributed to visibly cleaner dining areas and dancefloors, reducing litter across the festival environment.

#### **Waste Reduction**

The Rewash Program successfully prevented over 1.3 tonnes of singleuse packaging waste from reaching landfill.



#### **Vendor Engagement**

Improved pre-event communication, and a structured return system helped vendors better understand and comply with reuse deposit systems.



#### **Behaviour Change Through Education**

Thousands of festival-goers participated in campground conversations with B-Alternative, promoting conscious consumption and proper waste practices.



#### Circular Economy in Action

Salvaging efforts recovered camping gear including gazebos and chairs - for donation or reuse, extending product lifespans and supporting community-based circularity.

B-Alternative works closely with festival organisers to refine operations and expand the impact of reuse systems and peer-led waste education at festivals and events nationwide. 
